Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Assessments

Remember, you need to see a paediatrician to get a referral to see us for an ADHD assessment and you'll most likely need to go back and see them once our assessments have been completed) to formalise the outcome.

Initial consultation

This is a 1 hr phone or Zoom/Telehealth session where the practitioner will obtain relevant background information about your child and their current challenges.

WISC-V (Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children, Fifth Edition)

This is a structured standardised cognitive assessment which gives us a picture of your child's intellectual functioning. Your child attends this session with the psychologist and it usually takes between 1 to 1.5 hours to administer.

WIAT-III - (Wechsler Individual Achievement Test, Third Edition)

This assessment identifies the academic strengths and weaknesses of your child. Your child attends this session and it usually takes about 1.5 to 2 hours to administer.

Parent and Educator Questionnaires

BRIEF-2 questionnaire (Behaviour Rating Inventory of Executive Function - Second Edition) - this is an online questionnaire that parents and educators complete to provide information about where and why your child struggles in terms of their executive functioning.

BASC-3 questionnaire (Behaviour Assessment System for Children - Third Edition) - this online questionnaire is completed by parents and educators and the results give us information about your child's behaviours, in particular those associated with ADHD.

Connors-3 questionnaire - The Connors questionnaire is completed by parents and educators and provides a thorough assessment of ADHD and common associated difficulties.
