RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS PARENT/ GUARDIAN CONSENT FOR EXCURSION TO ST HELIERS, KOHIMARAMA, MISSION BAY

Leader will wear a fluro vest, have a mobile phone and First Aid kit

Students are required to adhere to School Rules for behaviour and conduct

Any personal effects are the responsibility of the student

If personal effects land in road or dangerous area, permission must be sought from Leader to retrieve

Crossing of road ONLY where and when Leader specifies and, where possible, at a designated pedestrian crossing

Hazards will be notified to whole group by Leader

Students to carry vital medication/inhalers

Appropriate clothing must be worn depending on weather – i.e. hats, sunblock, jacket, shoes

Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones

Student must inform Leader of any injury, illness, or discomfort during excursion

Leader may abandon excursion at their discretion and return to school

Leader must inform school if running late for return

NB Under this excursion form, there will be no swimming activities which require a separate water-based activity consent form.
