## 2017 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 110 hours over 13 days were spent in two **training sessions** for our program partners from India, Kenya, Rwanda, and Mozambique.
- More than 1,400 hours were given by interns and volunteers.
- Training curriculum was finalized and launched with our partners, offering them an eight-section guide focused on leadership, community development, cross-cultural adaptation, project management, fundraising, financial management, communications, and technology.
- Recruited six new community leaders who will begin their partnership in 2018.



# 2017 TOTAL INCOME



## **2017 TOTAL EXPENSES**


\$38,464
