Initial consultation

This is a 1 hr phone or Zoom/Telehealth session where the practitioner will obtain relevant background information about your child and their current challenges.

WISC-V (Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children, Fifth Edition)

This is a structured standardised cognitive assessment which gives us a picture of your child's intellectual functioning. Your child attends this session with the psychologist and it usually takes between 1 to 1.5 hours to administer.

WIAT-III - (Wechsler Individual Achievement Test, Third Edition)

this assessment identifies the academic strengths and weaknesses of your child. Your child attends this session and it usually takes about 1.5 to 2 hours to administer.

CTOPP -2 (Comprehensive Test of Phonological Processing - Second Edition)

This brief assessment (usually around 30 minutes) assesses your child's phonological abilities and identifies children who are significantly below their peers in this area as well as determining strengths and weaknesses.
