The documents that change (this applies to all types of condos):

Anytime:

- Notice of Special Assessment
- Notice of AGM (including approved AGM minutes from previous AGM)
- Notice of filing a Statement of Claim (found on the CAD)
- Change in condo management
- Rules and Regulation updates such as: Airbnb, Marijuana use, parking, pets, etc.

Monthly:

· Board meeting minutes

Bi-monthly:

 Current Balance Sheet, Profit and loss statement and budget comparison

Annually:

- Insurance Certificate
- Approved annual Operating budget
- Condo Fee notice

Every 5 years

- Reserve Fund Study and Plan
- Bylaw updates

Documents required vary for type of condominium plan registered:

Bare Land Condominium: these documents contain information that does not apply to conventional condo plan:

- Architectural controls (CAD)
- Bylaws definition of Managed Property
- Insurance
- Reserve fund Study and Plan
- Redivision Plans for Units (CAD)

Phased Condominium:

• Phasing Disclosure Statement (CAD)

The current documents that are available can be obtained or verified using the condo plan number at www.CondoPapers.com, or on many of the condo management websites. Checking to ensure you have the most current information will save time, money and stress during the sale.
