

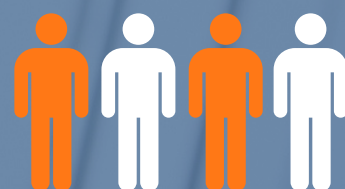

Parental Leave Trends

57%

Of fathers and one third of mothers report that their parental leave is 'too short'

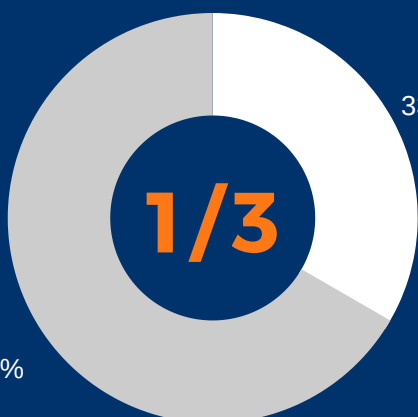

Mothers' jobs are much more likely to change than fathers' jobs



33.3% One in three mothers believe they missed out on an opportunity for promotion due to their use of paid parental leave.

66.7%

28% of mothers stay with their employer but report changes to their job. This compares to 96% of fathers who return to their same employer, with only 6% experiencing any job change.
