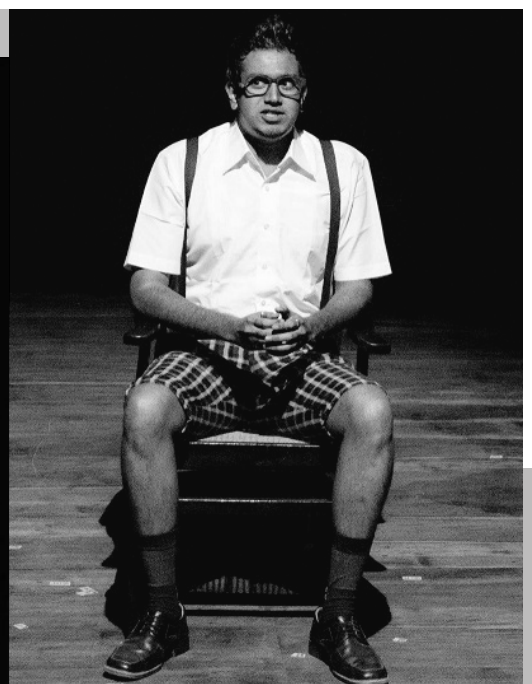

Do not factor in income from sources which are not directly related to your creative career. Income is in Australia Dollars. Please use a currency converter if you are outside Australia.

1.2 What is your career reach?

Include ticket/product sales, unique visitors to websites, article views, video views, number of people on mailing lists, number of friends/followers on social media. Do not include views on social media posts – there is too much user overlap and the impact is easily overstated.

1.3 How many people are in your networks?

Include people you have a personal relationship with. Do not include social media friends/followers who you haven't met or interacted with either in person or verbally.

1.4 How many times have you ever participated in media interviews?

E.g. radio, print, web, video, TV, podcasts.

1.5 Do you grow your networks by, on average, at least

1.6 Do you have testimonials from collaborators, industry leaders and/or fans which you are permitted to publicise?

1.7 During your career, how many times has your work received a positive review?


